In this section, the PBS team identified and defined the various types of disruptive behavior as well as interventions that will be used to reduce each type of behavior.

Disruptive Conduct	A disorderly, physical or verbal outburst, which results in a major disruption of learning and/or the school environment	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention	Repeated disruptive behavior, which results in a minor disruption of learning; unresolved with redirection.	Record infraction on the Focus Card Teach/re-teach expectation.
Physical Aggression	Fighting-when physical contact creates an unsafe environment.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention	Any body contact, i.e. play-fighting,	Record infraction on the Focus Card Teach/re-teach expectation.
Harassment/Bullying (Sexual, Verbal, Physical, Emotional or Technological)	Any kind of threat, bullying, intimidation, or verbal assault. Intimidation to the point of causing emotional distress.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention	Insults or teasing, in any form.	Record infraction on the Focus Card Teach/re-teach expectation.
Insubordination	Deliberate refusal to follow any school procedures.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention	Initial refusal, but eventual compliance.	Record infraction on the Focus Card Teach/re-teach expectation.
Inappropriate Language	Including profane, racial, ethnic and/or sexual slurs and/or gestures leading to insubordination, disruption, or harassment.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention	Use of Profane language	Record infraction on the Focus Card Teach/re-teach expectation.

<u>BEHAVIOR</u>	<u>MAJOR</u>	<u>INTERVENTION</u>	<u>MINOR</u>	<u>INTERVENTION</u>
Academic Misconduct/Dishonesty/Cheating	Cheating, Plagiarism (without author's permission), theft of teacher materials, tests, books, etc. This includes sharing homework.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention		
Technology abuse	Inappropriate use of technology, email, Social networking (Facebook, Twitter etc.) Games, inappropriate websites, obscene, offensive or non-educational sites. Ipods/cell phones	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention	Student is on inappropriate website.	Record infraction on the Focus Card Teach/re-teach expectation. Phone will be taken away until parents pick it up from the main office.
Vandalism/Defacing school Property.	Careless or intentional damage to any property that does not belong to the individual. (including Bathrooms, Hallways, Locker rooms, books, and computers)	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, Police notified, and/or Administrative Intervention		
Forgery	Use of someone's name/identity without permission(written, verbal, or technological).	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention		
Weapons	A student will not possess, handle, transmit, or use a dangerous instrument capable of harming another person. (I.e. knives, guns, chemicals, sharp objects, blunt objects etc.)	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, Police notified, and/or Administrative Intervention		
False Alarm	Pulling Fire alarms/ Dialing 911 inappropriately or creating false verbal reports.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/or Administrative Intervention

Controlled substance	Possession of or under the influence of alcohol, drugs prescribed, over-the-counter and or illegal or drug paraphernalia. (i.e. cigarettes, Marijuana, pain killers, Qat, model glue, aerosols, mouthwash, etc.)	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, Police notified, and/ or Administrative Intervention		
Dress code Violation	Refusal to comply with staff request to cover up or adjust inappropriate attire.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/ or Administrative Intervention	Student who comes to school with inappropriate clothing on.	Record infraction on the Focus Card Teach/re-teach expectation. Student will call home.
Theft	Student is in possession of someone else's property or is involved in the removal of another person's property without permission.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, Police notified, and/ or Administrative Intervention		
Trespassing	A student will remain at all times in the assigned/ scheduled school area. Students suspended or removed from the school will not return to the school premise without administrative authorization. Students will not linger on school property or adjacent property.	Detention Friday School (Levels 1-4), ISS, OSS, and/ or Administrative Intervention
